Update of the Career Guidance Work Team meeting on February 26, 2016.

Objective of CG Work Team -

1. Determine Essential Components required in a career information system for the 2016-2017 academic year in lowa public school districts.

Framework for Career Guidance and Iowa Code 279.61. Iowa school district requirements:

- 1. The lowa Department of Education (IDOE) approves the essential components included in a high quality career planning and decision-making information system (CIS).
- 2. The career guidance work team is in the process of determining the essential components of a CIS.
- 3. Vendors will submit CIS specs containing the essential components for IDOE approval.
- 4. Once approved the CIS will be added to an approved list of systems from which lowa districts may choose to meet the mandate.

Legislative Update:

Changes to Iowa Code <u>279.61</u> are included in <u>House File 2392</u> (starting on page 2, line 27)-Career Technical Education (CTE) including Career and Academic Planning. The bill passed unanimously in the House Education Committee On March 3, the full House of Representatives voted 96-0 in favor of the bill, as amended. It is now up for consideration in the Senate.

Career Guidance Work Team - Meeting Update from February 23, 2016:

If the bill language from <u>House File 2392</u> passes, schools will be required to prepare students to successfully complete the essential components of a career information and decision-making system that meets the adopted standards. With this in mind, the team:

- defined the draft elements of quality career guidance and
- identified the draft components to be completed by students in order for them to develop an academic and career plan.

Next Work Team Meeting: March 30, 2016

During the next meeting, the team will use the draft elements and components from the February meeting to:

- develop the final, essential elements of a quality career guidance system and components of the system,
- determine supports needed for high quality career guidance, and
- recommend minimum standards for a career information and decision-making systems (CIS).

Next Steps:

By the end of the current legislative session:

- 1. The Career Guidance Work Team will make recommendations to the State Board of Education.
- 2. The State Board of Education will adopt emergency rules, once the CTE bill becomes law.
- 3. The Department will provide lowa Code Chapter 279.61 compliance information and guidance to the field for academic year 2016-2017.
